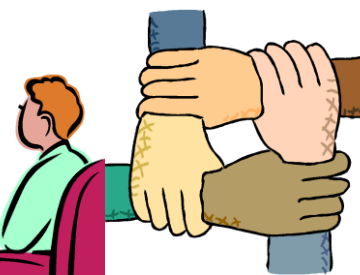

Keeping Your Children Drug-Free

Get Serious

There is a serious drug and alcohol problem in our country today. It affects children, teenagers, and adults of all races and religions, men and women, rich and poor. As parents, you want your children to grow up healthy, educated, and ready and able to meet the challenges of the future. But taking drugs can take that future away. Children need to understand that life can sometimes be lonely, boring, distressing, and unhappy. But they must also learn that taking a pill, smoking pot, or drinking liquor to get them through a difficult time can, in fact, make a bad situation worse.

Tips for parents

1. Be a good role model. Consider how your use of tobacco, alcohol, prescription medicines, and over-the-counter drugs influences your children.
2. Build your child's self-esteem. Help children to feel good about themselves by emphasizing what they do right.
3. Teach your children values such as honesty, self-reliance, and responsibility.
4. Educate yourself about alcohol and other drugs and give your children the straight facts.
5. Encourage good communication and decision-making skills.
6. Teach your children how to confidently say "NO" and resist peer pressure to use drugs.
7. Establish and enforce clear, strong, and consistent no alcohol/no drug use rules.
8. Teach your kids to manage stress in healthy ways (for example: exercise, hobbies, sports, and conversation).
9. Love your child unconditionally.
10. Guarantee your child that he/she can call you if they are having a problem – no questions asked.
11. Look for body language and listen to their tone of voice when they are asking you questions.
12. Ask questions about where they are going, who they are with, and where you can get in touch with them if they are with their friends.

They will link you to a SASS worker who will come talk with you and your child. They will make a plan for you and

work with your family for 90 days. They will link with hospitals, mental health and support services as needed. They conduct at-risk assessments in the home.
